HOW TO INTERVIEW

If possible, stage a mock interview with a Career Development staff member, a faculty member, or a friend By doing this, you can try out some of your answers and receive constructive feedback on the way that you present yourself You can also learn about any distracting habits, which can be eliminated before your interview

The 4 S's Interview

a Conduct the interview in an informal and warm way While you can make brief notes to remember what the student says, avoid typing answers or making the experience feel like a test b Your two primary objectives in getting to know the student's sparks, strengths, struggles, and supports are to make the student feel understood and validated

Interview as a Method for Qualitative Research

By seeking exceptions, you allow disconfirmation of your data and interpretations The disagreements guide you into the pool of potentially available data Probes become more specific, each interview begins with a very open-ended question Each informant is given a chance to contribute data uncontaminated by your interpretations

How to Approach your Interview

Your interview questions will vary with your industry, relationships and interviewee characteristics The objective is to understand aspects of their jobs and to link your questions about their networks to how they get things done Emper: Can you tell me about who the important people are in your network

Your answer can be something like: "They get their meals for half price" You can then tell them you'll be contacting them in the next few days The bad candidate won't hand you any references or thank you for the interview or shake your hand The question from the good candidate is: "Your staff has such a good reputation for customer

interview Review your resume, practice your One-Minute Resume speech, review your research on the company, practice the answers to common interview questions, and review the questions you plan to ask • Plan your day around the interview Avoid rushing by mapping out the directions to the interview

Sample Interview Questions with Appropriate Answers

In asking this behavioral interview question the interviewer wants to know if you are able to accurately complete your tasks with close attention to all aspects of your work and carefully control errors In your interview answer show that you are concerned with maintaining accuracy and check your work for errors
